Wounded Warrior Athlete Initiative Update Improving wound and skin care through education and awareness

The Wound Healing Society Foundation (WHSF) has expanded its Wounded Warrior Athlete Initiative in 2014 with two incredible events.

WHSF provided approximately 250 Warrior Care kits for athletes participating in the Warrior Games in Colorado Springs, Colorado (September 28 – October 4, 2014) to active and veteran U.S. service members from Special Ops, Navy, Marines, Army, and Air Force.

Additionally, WHSF supplied Warrior Care kits and Pressure Ulcer Prevention educational brochures for competitors of the inaugural 2014 Invictus Games held in London, England, September 10-14, 2014. Over 400 active and veteran service members from 13 countries competed before crowds of 65,000 people. WHSF was there and offered awareness and education to this remarkable group of athletes and their caregivers.

Supporting wounded warrior athletes and their families is one way the WHSF delivers on our Mission. Together we can improve wound and skin care through education and awareness.
